

Tennis is a challenging and exhilarating sport, and the Bourne Club offers a fantastic opportunity for players of all ages and abilities to get involved. We currently have five outdoor courts (one Edel Soft astro, two Olympus astro and two Matchplay II carpet) plus one indoor court (acrylic). All courts are floodlit and allow play to take place from 8:00am to at least 10:00pm. Court bookings are made using our online booking system, and Members are able to reserve slots up to two weeks in advance.

Our adult Club Programme includes Club Nights on Tuesday and Friday evenings (7:00pm onwards), Ladies Mornings and Afternoons throughout term time (Thursday mornings 9:00 – 11:30am and Monday afternoons 1:30 – 3:30pm) and Mens' Mornings (Saturdays 8:00 – 10:00am and Sundays 10:00 – 12:00pm). All such sessions benefit from pre booked courts, leaving Members to simply turn up, pay and play!



Each year the Club holds its annual Championships throughout June, and further competitive opportunities are available year round in the Mixed Singles, Ladies Doubles and Mixed Doubles Leagues. The Club also enters teams into various summer and winter competitions, including the prestigious National Club League.

For juniors, the Bourne is proud to be both a Mini Tennis Centre and County Accredited Performance Club. Such LTA recognition is given to Clubs that can demonstrate high levels of performance, both in terms of organised activities for juniors and a track record of producing players to county and national standards. Our junior Club Programme is spearheaded by Head Pro Andy Warry (PCA Licensed Level 3) and his team of excellent coaches, all of whom are LTA qualified and licensed.



As well as offering a comprehensive range of after school and pay and play group coaching sessions for youngsters, the Club also fields various junior teams, ranging from those competing at Mini Tennis Red level to Performance Players entering the National Junior Club League. The provision of suitable competition is vital for the successful development of young talent, and the Bourne is pleased to offer opportunities for players of all ages and abilities.

Coaching is also available to adults with a variety of group courses and drills being on offer. Courses allow players to progress within a set framework alongside players of a similar ability, whereas the drills allow players to flexibly pick and choose which sessions best meet their needs.

Private tuition can also be booked by all players keen to maximise their potential.
